Curt Adams is the associate dean for research for the Jeannine Rainbolt College of Education at the University of Oklahoma. He is co-founder and co-director of the Oklahoma Center for Education Policy, where he conducts research on social-psychological conditions in school systems, accountability policy, improvement science and performance measurement.

In 2014, he received the Linda Clarke Anderson Presidential Professorship for outstanding contribution to the university, field and community through research, teaching and service. Curt is also the founder and past director of the San Miguel School of Tulsa, a nonprofit school that serves socially deprived students and families.

Curt holds a master's degree in school psychology and a bachelor's degree in history with a minor in business from the University of Tulsa, and a doctoral degree in educational administration and policy studies from Oklahoma State University.
