



### **Board Member: Mick Cornett**

Mick Cornett was the first mayor in Oklahoma City history to be elected to a fourth term. During his time in office, Oklahoma City invested nearly \$2 billion in schools and infrastructure, generating nearly \$6 billion in private sector investment. His leadership was also instrumental in bringing the NBA to OKC.

Mick provided oversight for the completion of MAPS for Kids, one of the nation's largest citywide investments in public education. He championed the passage of MAPS 3, which includes a new convention center, a 70-acre downtown park, modern streetcar system, the nation's most advanced whitewater rafting facility, senior wellness centers, hundreds of miles of new bike trails and sidewalks, and a new fairgrounds expo building.

He is one of the nation's foremost spokesmen for municipal issues and is frequently asked to speak to Congress, the White House and national media on behalf of cities across the nation. He was president of the U.S. Conference of Mayors from June 2016 to June 2017.

Mick produced, wrote and directed the award-winning documentary, "Oklahoma City: The Boom, The Bust and The Bomb." The documentary earned top honors at New Jersey's Golden Door Film Festival.

Mick holds a bachelor of arts in journalism from the University of Oklahoma and an MBA from New York University. He has three adult sons and lives in Oklahoma City with his wife, Terri.
