### Covid-19 Testing Resources

**Harold Hamm Building** – OU Medicine offers testing by appointment only by calling the scheduling line at (405) 271.7773. Hours of Operation: Monday-Friday 7:30am – 6:30pm, Saturday – Sunday 8:30am – 4:30pm. Testing Site Location: 701 NE 8<sup>th</sup> Street at the Harold Hamm Diabetes Center, Testing available for adults and pediatrics.

**OK Health Department** – To make an appointment, call (405) 425.4489. If you don't get an answer, and/or the phone hangs up after the automated message, continue to call back until you get through. They only make appointments for the next day, so if they are full, you will need to call again the next morning. Results are received in 5-7 business days.

Patients should not have any out-of-pocket costs, but you should check with your health plan to confirm before scheduling a test. If you have health insurance, you must bring your card with you to the test site. If you do not have insurance, we will ask you for your Social Security number (card not needed), driver's license or state ID to submit the cost of your test to the federal program for the uninsured.
